Kids' Motorcycles & ATVs Banned!

Sunday February 15, 2009

It sounds like a hoax, but it's true: children's motorcycles and ATVs are now illegal in America, effective February 10, 2009. Thanks to the well-intentioned but ill-applied Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act, offroad motorcycles and ATVs intended for those 12 years old and younger are now illegal because their batteries contain lead.



The ruling was "...intended to address lead in toys and children's jewelry that kids put in their mouths," according to Paul Vitano, General Counsel for the Motorcycle Industry Council and the Specialty Vehicle Institute of America. "We're concerned about this for a variety of reasons," he says, "in particular because the lack of availability of youth products makes it more likely that youth are going to ride adult size products. And that's a real risk to children."

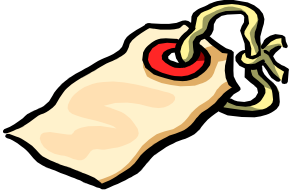
***Let's Have some fun at our March Meeting on Saturday
